Major Areas of Accountability:

The successful candidate will manage the activities and personnel in the manufacturing area which relates or contributes to a consistently high quality product.

Essential Functions:

1. Lead and develop quality control personnel and optimize team performance.
2. Continually improve standards and techniques to ensure that processes are in control and finished products meet customer specifications.
3. Work with the production team to resolve and correct production techniques/practices which result in quality problems and/or customer complaints. Strong trouble shooting skills are critical.
4. Interact with the Research and Development staff, on behalf of the Manufacturing group, to ensure that (a) new formulations are ready for production scale up, and (b) problem formulations are investigated and corrective action taken to resolve the issues.
5. Lead the effort to investigate product non conformances and customer complaints, identify root causes, and help initiate effective corrective action.
6. Lead ISO9000 compliance efforts. Ensure that lab equipment is properly maintained and calibrated. Keep quality control training personnel training current.
7. Insure quality control testing is done correctly and promptly, test results are documented, and data is reviewed for trends.
8. Lead plant efforts to minimize the generation and inventory of overage materials, off grade materials, and scrap.
9. Develop and manage quality control resources, budgets and expenses.
10. Work closely with the plant staff to make communicate and reach plant quality goals.
11. Plant operates 24 hours/day, 7 days per week—so after hours availability is required periodically.
12. Punctuality and regularity of attendance are job requirements.

5. Management experience is preferred.
6. Strong communications skills and ability to work well with others.
7. Strong computer skills. Proficient with spreadsheets and databases.
